Rocker **Eddie Money** has a new place where he can take someone home tonight. The singer/songwriter has just moved into a 1,000-square-foot one-bedroom at 40 Central Park South. The prewar unit includes a woodburning fireplace.

Money is currently in town to work on his autobiographical musical, "Two Tickets to Paradise," and will be holding a talent search for the lead role of young Eddie.

One-bedroom rentals in 40 Central Park South start at around \$3,000 a month and can fetch upwards of \$6,000 a month.
