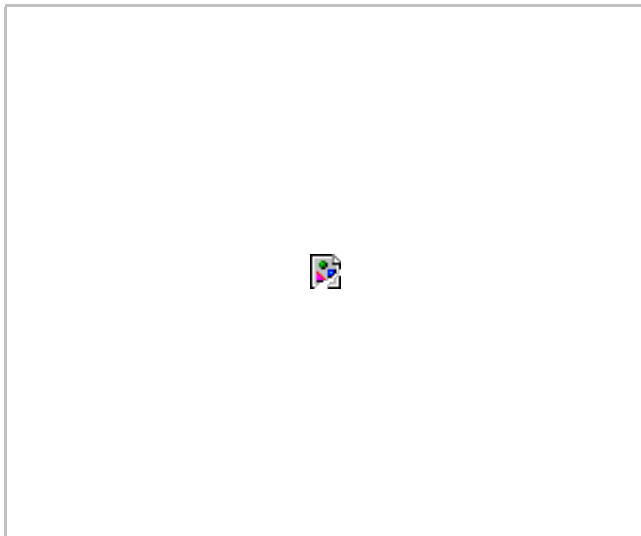

To fuel a deal, the firm, tapped as the exclusive sales team for the building, is offering the incentive in addition to commission.

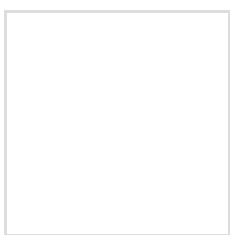
