



Singer Lisa Stansfield selling Chelsea loft for \$3.65M

R&B star Lisa Stansfield — best known for the 1989 hit “All Around the World” — is in contract to sell her two-bedroom, two-bathroom, prewar loft in the Chelsea Mercantile.

It’s the same building where Katie Holmes sought refuge following her divorce from Tom Cruise, though the actress has since left the building.

Stansfield’s 1,600-square-foot unit was asking \$3.65 million. It comes with storage space in the basement. Building amenities include a gym, playroom and a 10,000-square-foot roof deck — there’s a Whole Foods there, too.

Listing broker, Rutenberg’s Susan Forrest-Reynolds, declined to comment.
