







224 CENTRE STREET SOHO, NEW YORK

Also known as Odd Fellows' Hall, 224 Centre Street was constructed in 1848 as the New York Headquarters of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, an organization that aided the poor.

It's handsome brownstone facade, Queen Anne mansard roof and many decorated chimneys helped 224 Centre Street quickly become an ionic New York City sight.
